RESOLUTION 2020-04

2020 FIRE ASSESSMENT CERTIFICATION

WHEREAS, the West Manatee Fire & Rescue District ("District") in accordance with the provisions of Section 12, Chapter 2000-401 F.S., must review, adjust, correct and certify the fire assessment levied against every parcel of property within the District; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Florida Statutes 197.3632, the Board must conduct a Public Hearing to annually review, adjust, correct and certify the non-ad valorem assessment roll levied against every parcel of property within the District; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Fire Commissioners did adopt Resolution 2020-02 on May 19, 2020 specifying the rate of assessment to be applied to all taxable property for the 2020-2021 tax year; and,

WHEREAS, the District has received from the Manatee County Property Appraiser a fire assessment roll for the 2020-2021 tax year and subsequently checked it and noted any necessary corrections and/or adjustments; and,

WHEREAS, a properly advertised Public Hearing was held on September 8, 2020 to hear appeals from any property owner in the District with respect to the method of calculation or the amount of fire assessment levied against a parcel of land within the District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Fire Commissioners of West Manatee Fire & Rescue District did receive and consider the following fire assessment appeal(s) and have notified all parties in writing of the reason for granting or denying each.
